

Antony

Caesar's loyal friend who runs in a race, Speaks at Caesar's funeral, Starts riots against the conspirators, part of the Triumvirate. (Seen throughout the play)



Caesar

Popular, victorious over Pompey and family, He's like the Roman President. (Killed in Act 3)



Artemidorus

Wrote a letter warning Caesar to watch out for the conspirators and names them. Caesar does not read it. (Acts 2 and 3)



Calpurnia

Caesar's wife, can't have kids, does not want Caesar to go to the senate on the Ides of March. (First half of the play)



Brutus

Patriotic and Honorable, loves Caesar but loves his country more, involved in the conspiracy and messes up a lot. (Seen throughout the play)




Carpenter

Commoner, makes/builds things, caught celebrating Caesar. (Act 1, scene 1)

Dislikes commoners, hates Caesar, stabs Caesar first, co-conspirator, and sassy. (Seen several times during the play)



Casca



Cassius

Despises Caesar, manipulative, forges letters and sends them to Brutus to get him on his side, starts the Conspiracy. (Seen throughout the play)



Cobbler

Fixes shoes, commoner, caught celebrating Caesar and adds humor to the play. (Act 1, scene 1)



Cicero

"Speaks Greek", Orator, Killed in act 4 by Antony and Octavius' men.



Clitus

A Soldier in Brutus' army, one of the last to survive and follow him. (Act 5)



Cinna

Conspirator who suggests to Cassius that Brutus should join the Conspiracy, Stabs Caesar. (Seen several times during the play)



Decius Brutus

Conspirator, persuades Caesar to go to the senate, Stabs Caesar. (Seen several times during the play)



Flavius

Tribune, Supports Pompey, hates Caesar. "put to silence" for tearing off the scarves from Caesar's statues. (Act 1)



Lucius

Servant to Brutus, brings him one of the forged letters, plays music. (Seen several times during the play)



Lepidus

Part of the Triumvirate with Antony and Octavius. Called "Slight" by Antony. (Act 4)




Marullus

Tribune (official chosen by the people), fan of Pompey, "put to silence" with Flavius. (Act 1)



Lucilius

Brutus' friend and co-conspirator. (Act 4)



Messala

Officer in Brutus' army. Tells him that 100 senators are to be put to death. (Act 4)



Metellus Cimber

Conspirator, the one whose brother has been ex-communicated by Caesar. This is brought up right before they kill Caesar. (Act 3)



Popilius Lena

Freaks Cassius out by saying "may your enterprise thrive" right before they kill Caesar. (Act 3)



Octavius

Caesar's adopted son/nephew who is seeking revenge for Caesar's death. Part of the triumvirate. (Second half of the play)



Portia

Brutus' dead wife, kills herself by swallowing hot coals. (First half of the play)



Publius

Old man who gets scared when Caesar was murdered, named by Lepidus to die in Act 4



Pindarus

Cassius' servant, falsely reports to Cassius that Brutus has been captured (Act 5)



Servant to Octavius

Tells Octavius to wait to come to Rome after seeing Caesar's dead body. (Act 3)



Soothsayer

Sees the future,
warns Caesar to
“Beware the Ides of
March” (March 15)
(Act 1, Scene 2 and
Act 3, Scene 1)



Strato

The loyal servant
who holds Brutus'
sword so that he
may commit
suicide. Later, he
becomes a servant
to Octavius. (Act 5)



Trebonius

Conspirator, Pulled
Antony out of the
way when they killed
Caesar in order to
distract him. (Act 3)



Voluminius

A friend of Brutus
and a soldier under
his command at
Philippi. He refuses
to hold a sword for
Brutus to impale
himself on. (Act 5)
