

Vocabulary Set #10

Stable: Adj. Not likely to change or fail; **firmly established**

- Synonyms: Solid, strong, steady, firm
- N. A building set apart and adapted for keeping horses
- Basically, **a barn for horses**

Lipoprotein: N. any of a group of soluble proteins that combine with and transport fat or other lipids in the **blood and plasma**

- Lipoproteins are proteins that combine with fat and lipids **and then move** fats and lipids through the blood

Petition: N. A formal **written request**, typically one signed by many people, appealing to authority with respect to a particular cause.

V. Make or present a formal request to (an authority) with respect to **a particular cause.**

- She was asked to sign a petition against plans to build on the local playing fields.
- Americans who moved west **petitioned congress** for admission to the Union as states.

Prohibit: V. formally forbid (something) by law, rule, **or other authority.**



Radical: Adj. (especially of change or action) relating to or affecting **the fundamental nature** of something; far-reaching or thorough

- A radical change in the policy of a company
- N. A person who follows strong convictions or **extreme principles.**
- The group of politicians were extreme republican radicals.
