Institute: N. 1. a society or organization for carrying on a particular work, as of a literary, scientific, or educational character *the Institute for Advanced Studies.

V. 2. To set up, establish, organize *to institute a government

Automate: v to run or operate (something, such as a factory or system) by using machines, computers, etc., instead of people to do the work *Automated

answering services, whenever a robot answers

Vogue: N. Something (such as a way of dressing or behaving) that is fashionable or popular in a particular time and place.
