1. Incorporated: Adj. (of a company or other organization) formed into a legal corporation



2. Detach: V. to unfasten and separate; disengage; disunite
Detachable: Adj. designed to be unfastened or disconnected without damage; "shirts with detachable collars"
 - The man wore a **detachable** name tag on his work shirt.
 - She felt **detached** from the group.

3. Bean: V. hit (someone) on the head
 - Not just a delicious side dish!



4. Sulk: V. be silent, morose, and bad-tempered out of annoyance or disappointment
 - Face your problems and don't **sulk** when you get home!
 - The **sulking** teenager, with a frowning face and crossed arms, refused to leave her room after a bad day.
5. Embody: V. to represent (something) in a clear and obvious way: to be a symbol or example of (something)
 - Synonyms: personify, symbolize, represent, epitomize
