Arraign: call or bring (someone) before a court to answer a criminal charge.

Find fault with (someone or something); censure.



Outburst: a sudden release of strong emotion.

a sudden outbreak of a particular activity.

- "'she screamed at him about it one day," said one source who witnessed the outburst".
- a wild outburst of applause took over the entire gymnasium.

Proclivity: a tendency to choose or do something regularly; an inclination or predisposition toward a particular thing; a natural tendency

- He has a proclivity for exaggeration.
- France was apprehensive of the king's proclivity towards an alliance, not merely peace, with Spain.

Underlying: (especially of a layer of rock or soil) lie or be situated under (something).
be the cause or basis of (something).

- Dirt underlies grass on the ground
- Being overweight can be the underlying cause of some health problems

Conserve: protect (something, especially an environmentally or culturally important place or thing) from harm or destruction or waste.
