

Vocabulary set 8

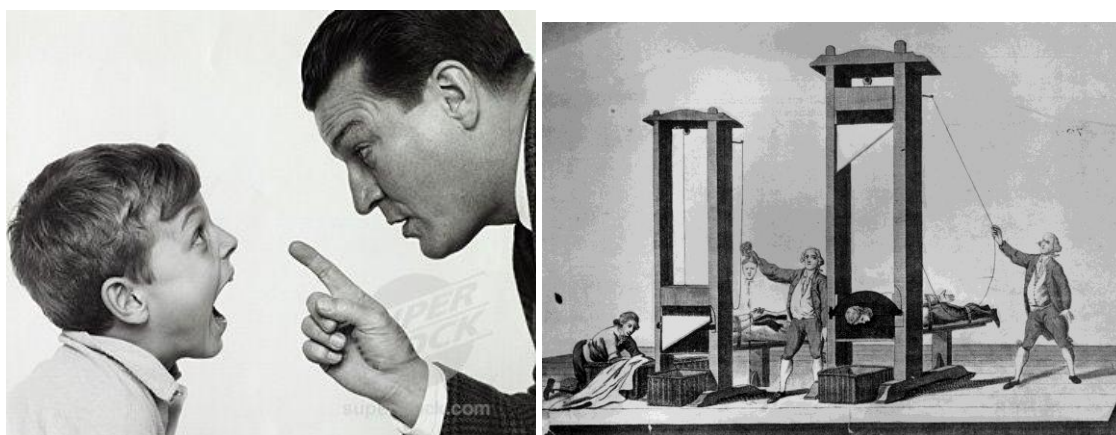
Advocate: N. a person who publicly supports or recommends a particular cause or policy. OR
V. publicly recommend or support.

- Demi Lovato is an advocate for the anti-bullying campaign.
- Advocate higher salaries for teachers!!

Entice: V. attract or tempt by offering pleasure or advantage. OR
Adj. attractive or tempting

- The new movie out in theaters should entice the audience to come and watch it.
- The new movie looks very enticing

Condemn: v. express complete disapproval of, typically in public; censure. OR
Sentence (someone) to a particular punishment, especially death.



Ailment: N. an illness, or bodily disorder, typically a minor one.

Examples of ailments: Acne, Cancer, Migraines, Sore throat, Diabetes

Susceptible: likely or liable to be influenced or harmed by a particular thing.

- Patients with liver disease may be susceptible to infection
- The young child is susceptible to the harsh language that his parents use.
